An investigator from the FBI and a trial attorney from the Department of Justice's Antitrust Division paid a visit to my home this morning at 7:15 am to ask me a few questions and hand me the attached Subpoena. I wasn't alone. Greg Pruett also had visitors at his house and from what I understand...investigators showed up at SK's headquarters in Monterey and Lemoore...all at the same approximate time.

I suspect this effort is being sponsored by Morningstar in retaliation for a lawsuit filed against them by SK Foods.

The Subpoena requires me to appear in front of the Grand Jury in Sacramento on May 15th and present vast amounts of documents relating to our tomato business. I'm in the process of finding an attorney to represent our interests. John Harris has already provided a couple of leads....

Most of the questions asked this morning pertained to our relationship with CTGA and price determination. They then asked questions regarding CTEG...our export trading group and the WTA, World Tomato Alliance that includes CTEG and two foreign producers of products Merko (Turkish) and Cendenco (Australian). These questions were pretty basic/generic.

When they started asking me very direct questions regarding any forms of communications pertaining to markets, customers, etc, etc,...I said I would feel more comfortable with an attorney present.

I'll be on the Westside tomorrow...perhaps we could meet sometime after 1 pm. I have a conference call at noon...and a meeting at 10 am.
